GUIDELINES FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS ACTIVITIES DURING MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (MCO) 12 MAY 2021 TO 7 JUNE 2021

Following the announcement by the Prime Minister of Malaysia on 11 May 2021 regarding the enforcement of Movement Control Order (MCO) in all states from 12 May to 7 June 2021, the Graduate Studies, Research and International Office, Faculty of Agriculture Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) has decided on the following actions regarding all the postgraduate activities in line with the guidelines of Universiti Putra Malaysia GP PKP Bil 7 2021

- a) Degree without thesis (Coursework)
- i) Master of Land Resource Management
- ii) Master of Plantation Management
- b) Degree with thesis (Coursework and Research)
 Master of Science (MS) and Doctor of Philosophy (PhD)
- i) Only postgraduate students that have obtained the approval of the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Student Affairs and Alumni) are allowed to enter the UPM campus.

Teaching and learning sessions (both lectures & practical) for all students will be conducted through an online platform. Please communicate closely with your course coordinator/lecturer.

Postgraduate students (with thesis) who have to complete their research activities must obtain the approval of the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Student Affairs and Alumni) before entering the UPM campus.

As a measure to prevent the spread of Covid-19, all postgraduate students are required to abide to all the rules & regulations in Faculty of Agriculture following all the relevant SOPs.
