

Instructions to Write an Abstract for The 8th International Agriculture Students Symposium (IASS)

Since 2008, International Agriculture Students Symposium (IASS) on Food, Agriculture, and Environment has been held at University of Putra Malaysia. The 8th IASS 2024 will focus on "Youth Engagement & Innovation: Towards A Sustainable Future in Agriculture".

In order to have fruitful discussions with other students and scholars from around the world about student actions or activities in the fields of food, agriculture, and environment, we invite you to present your current research, project, or other initiatives **related to the IASS theme of this year**. You will be doing this in your capacity as a representative student of your university. The abstract and the presentation may include (but not limited to) the following ideas:

- ➤ What issues does your community have with food, agriculture, and the environment?
- ➤ What steps have you taken to address these issues (such as the rollout of a programme or activity)?
- ➤ What effects do these initiatives or programmes have on the social, economic, and environmental spheres
- > How do other young people participate in these initiatives or activities? Why do they do it?
- > Do you encounter any obstacles when promoting your initiatives? How could these initiatives grow and continue?

Please have an academic advisor to guide you through with the abstract and presentation preparation.

Kindly utilize the World file < IASS_Template_Abstract> when composing your abstract and extended abstract.

To guarantee that your abstract is properly completed and submitted, kindly use the following checklist.

Abstracts must be submitted by January 31, 2025, with a maximum of 500 words.
The abstract should be a complete paragraph that includes an introduction , objective , method result , and conclusion .
Use Microsoft Word.
Your abstract should be single-spaced .
For all content, Times New Roman should be used. Your name, the name of your academic advisor, the name of your university, and the primary content should all be 12 points in size. The title should be 14 points . The first line of your paper should be centered with the title ; skip one line and type your name on the third line; the affiliation and advisor's name should centered below your name on the fourth and fifth lines, respectively.
Participant needs to download IASS_Abstract_Template to write the full abstract for your founding, participants is prohibited to edit the template directly on the google drive.
